WISE VS FOOLISH VIRGINS

As I look around and watch what is happening in our world, I get the feeling that the people "of the world" seem to think they're going to live forever! It seems that life is about the "all mighty dollar!" Getting ahead in life (whatever that means) and making sure that one day they can sit on their dock, back porch, or yacht... "kick back" and feel good about all they have accomplished in life... *without any feelings about a relationship with our Lord!*

Let's look at a story in the Bible that tells of this in a similar way. In Matthew 25:1-13 Jesus tells a parable about ten virgins. This group of ladies are waiting for the bridegroom to show up, but he was delayed and they all become drowsy and fall asleep. Verses 6-9: "At midnight they were aroused by the shout, 'Look, the bridegroom is coming! Come out and meet him!' All the bridesmaids got up and prepared their lamps. Then the five foolish ones asked the others, 'Please give us some of your oil because our lamps are going out.' But the others replied, 'We don't have enough for all of us. Go to a shop and buy some for yourselves.'" And, we know the rest of the story. While the five foolish virgins were gone to purchase oil, the bridegroom came. The wise ones that were "ready" went in to the marriage feast, and the door was locked!

QUESTION: As we live in this world today, are we the five wise virgins who were prepared when the bridegroom returned, or are we the five foolish who "were not" ready?

THINK ABOUT IT: "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself." (Matt. 22:37-39)

If we say we love Him, do we show it in how we live for Him?
