I Can't Do This!

Have you ever gotten to a place in your life when you were just overwhelmed by the challenge that was before you? If not, then just wait, it is coming! Most of us probably face obstacles like that all the time. It is in those moments that we come face to face with our own inadequacies that we are right where we need to be! Only in our desperation do we look to the source that can deliver us!

Paul lamented about the challenges he faced in 2 Corinthians 3:5, "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves..." You would think that if anyone could handle the challenges, it would be Paul; but even he was not adequate. This is the reality Jesus tries to remind us of in John 15:5, "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing." No one likes to hear they can do nothing (by no one I mean me); but we all need that understanding. It is only there that we are reminded we need God! Paul finished his statement of insufficiency by saying, "...but our sufficiency is from God." Jesus contrasted his statement on being able to do nothing by reminding his followers in Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

What we need is not a magic formula that will make all our troubles go away. That will never happen, so we should stop looking for it. What we need is to turn to the source of true power and strength WHO will walk with us even through the valley of the shadow of death. In those moments we are overwhelmed by life, we can know that we are not alone. With Him we can say, "I CAN DO THIS!"
